START UP PROCEDURES:

- 1. Ensure pump is fully primed.
- 2. Ensure PTO is disengaged.
- 3. ½ Throttle.
- 4. Hold permissive button until you have oil pressure reading, should be approximately 75-100 PSI. Release red button.
- 5. Engage PTO with RPM no higher that 1,000.
- 6. Check pump pressure at discharge.
- 7. No pressure: continue to prime while pump is in operation.
- 8. Pressure at discharge Gauge: secure priming system.
- 9. Adjust throttle to desired pump pressure, not to exceed 2,000 RPM.

TO STOP ENGINE:

- 1. Throttle engine below 1,000 RPM. Disengage PTO.
- 2. Run engine at no load for 10 minutes to cool turbo charger.
- 3. Push stop button.

SYSTEM PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE:

- 1. Change engine oil every 200 hours of operation.
- 2. Change oil, air and fuel filters every 200 hours of operation.
- 3. Use DELO 400, SAE 15-40 or equal.
- 4. Grease PTO and pump main bearings every 100 hours of operation. Use #2 Black Pearl Polyurea or equal. *Do not use lithium-based greases*.
